OVERVIEW: Section 10.3 of S.L. 2024-1 repeals the extension of drivers license duration and the allowance for unlimited remote drivers license renewals.

This section became effective July 1, 2023.

CURRENT LAW/BILL ANALYSIS: Section 41.14(a) of S.L. 2023-134 enacted statutory revisions to drivers license issuance laws to increase the validity period of a drivers license from 8 years to 16 years, and required the Division of Motor Vehicles to offer remote renewal of a drivers license or remote conversion of a full provisional license issued by the Division without restrictions.

This section repeals the extension of drivers license duration and the allowance for unlimited remote drivers license renewals to remain compliant with the federal REAL ID Act.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This section became effective July 1, 2023.
