SENATE BILL 527: ABC Omnibus 2023-24, Sec. 12: Allow Sale of Two Mixed Beverages at Spirituous Liquor Special Events

OVERVIEW: Section 12 of S.L. 2024-41 allows the holder of a spirituous liquor special event permit to sell two mixed beverages to a customer in a calendar day.

This section became effective July 8, 2024.

CURRENT AND PRIOR LAW: A spirituous liquor special event permit authorizes the permittee to give free tastings of its products, sell mixed beverages, and provide at no cost spirituous liquor distilled or produced at the distillery in closed containers at trade shows, conventions, agricultural festivals, farmers markets, local fund-raisers, and other similar events approved by the Commission. Prior to the enactment of this section, the sale of mixed beverages was limited to one mixed beverage per customer per calendar day.

BILL ANALYSIS: Section 12 of S.L. 2024-41 allows the holder of a spirituous liquor special event permit to sell two mixed beverages to a customer in a calendar day.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This section became effective July 8, 2024.
