

## **SENATE BILL 582:**

## North Carolina Farm Act of 2023, Sec. 8: Designate the Longleaf Pine as the Emblem Representing the Trees of North Carolina

OVERVIEW: Section 8 of S.L. 2023-63 designates the longleaf pine as the emblem representing the trees of North Carolina.

This bill was vetoed by the Governor on June 23, 2023, and that veto was overridden by the General Assembly on June 27, 2023.

This section became effective June 27, 2023.

BILL ANALYSIS: The pine tree is the official State tree of North Carolina. Section 8 of S.L. 2023-63 designates the longleaf pine as the emblem representing the trees of North Carolina.

## **EFFECTIVE DATE:**

This bill was vetoed by the Governor on June 23, 2023, and that veto was overridden by the General Assembly on June 27, 2023.
