Reports on Certain Procurement Methods Authorized in Disaster Areas

OVERVIEW: Section 4G.2 of S.L. 2024-53 requires the Department of Transportation (Department) to submit reports to the Joint Legislative Transportation Oversight Committee (JLTOC) and the Fiscal Research Division (FRD) for certain projects utilizing alternative project delivery methods within Hurricane Helene affected areas.

This section became effective October 25, 2024.

CURRENT LAW/BILL ANALYSIS:

Section 11.3 of S.L. 2024-51 authorizes the Department of Transportation to utilize various alternative project delivery methodologies for the repair and replacement of transportation infrastructure damaged or destroyed by Hurricane Helene in affected counties outlined in Section 4.1 of S.L. 2024-51. These alternative delivery methods are: progressive design build; design build; indefinite delivery indefinite quantity; and construction manager general contractor.

Section 4G.2 requires the Department to submit reports to JLTOC and FRD summarizing project and contract specifics (within 30 days of contract finalization) and project completion details (within 30 days of project completion) for progressive design build projects exceeding \$500 million or construction manager general contractor projects exceeding \$750 million.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This section became effective October 25, 2024.
