OVERVIEW: *Section 4B.5 of S.L. 2024-53 exempts funds allocated in this act to the Division of Child Development and Early Education, Department of Health and Human Resources, for the North Carolina Partnership for Children, Inc., to provide support through local partnerships to child care centers and family child care homes impacted by Hurricane Helene from the following requirements:*

- *Administrative costs under Section 9D.5(b) of S.L. 2023-134.*
- *Child care services funding under G.S. 143B-168.15(b).*
- *Child care subsidy expansion under G.S. 143B-168.15(g).*
- *Matching under Section 9D.5(d) of S.L. 2023-134.*

This section became effective October 25, 2024.
