## **Authorize Use of Permitted Mines as Temporary Debris Disposal Sites**

OVERVIEW: Section 4C.10 of S.L. 2024-53 authorizes the Department of Environmental Quality, upon agreement of a mine permittee, to allow storage of storm-related debris at a permitted mine when a state of emergency has been declared by the Governor due to a natural disaster or a pending disaster. The temporary storage of such waste would be authorized for a period not to exceed one year from the end of the state of emergency, and would not require a modification of a mine's permit. For purposes of this section, "storm-related debris" means construction and demolition debris and yard trash that originates from designated counties in an emergency area.

This section became effective October 25, 2024.
