OVERVIEW: *The Proposed Committee Substitute (PCS) for House Bill 1025 would allow the Mayor of Conetoe to vote on any matter before the Board of Commissioners. The PCS makes a technical change.*

CURRENT LAW AND BILL ANALYSIS: Under current law, the Mayor of Conetoe must not vote on any question before the Board of Commissioners unless there is a tie. The PCS for House Bill 1025 would allow the Mayor of Conetoe to vote on any question before the Board.

EFFECTIVE DATE: The act would be effective when it becomes law.
