OVERVIEW: *House Bill 1094 would direct the State Auditor to conduct a performance audit of the Ferry Division of the Department of Transportation and provide a report by January 15, 2027.*

This legislation was recommended by the Joint Legislative Transportation Oversight Committee.

[As introduced, this bill was identical to S902, as introduced by Sens. Rabon, Sawyer, Lazzara, which is currently in Senate Transportation.]

BILL ANALYSIS: House Bill 1094 would require the Office of the State Auditor to conduct a performance audit of the Ferry Division of the Department of Transportation. The audit would include evaluation of the Division's spending and budget practices, its operations and long-term strategies to maximize revenue and reduce costs, potential route and schedule adjustments, and options to diversify revenue.

The State Auditor would be required to provide a report to the Joint Legislative Transportation Oversight Committee and the Fiscal Research Division no later than January 15, 2027.

EFFECTIVE DATE: The act would be effective when it becomes law.
