HOUSE BILL 1104: Improve IVC Process and Enhance Public Safety, Sec. 3: Plan to Utilize Mobile Crisis Units to Complete Involuntary Commitment First Examinations

Analysis of: S.L. 2026-38, Sec. 3

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Section 3 of S.L. 2026-38 (House Bill 1104) directs the Local Management Entities/Managed Care Organizations (LME/MCOs) and the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) to develop a plan to use mobile crisis units to enhance the efficiency of the involuntary commitment (IVC) process. The LME/MCOs and DHHS are required to consult with relevant stakeholders in developing this plan.

The LME/MCOs and DHHS must submit a report on the plan to the Joint Legislative Oversight Committee on Health and Human Services and the Fiscal Research Division by October 1, 2026.

This section became effective on July 6, 2026.

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
