**OVERVIEW:** *The Proposed Committee Substitute for House Bill 1109 would direct the North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) to study the Strategic Prioritization Funding Plan for Transportation Investments (STI) laws, as recommended by the House Select Committee on North Carolina's Transportation Future.*

- *The PCS includes "related alternative funding scenarios" as part of the study.*

### CURRENT LAW/BILL ANALYSIS:

Article 14B of Chapter 136 of the General Statutes, Strategic Prioritization Funding Plan for Transportation Investments (STI), statutorily specifies how certain Highway Trust Fund funds and federal aid funds are allocated and utilized in developing the State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP), which identifies transportation projects and outlines project funding.

This PCS would direct the NCDOT to study project delivery performance for projects prioritized utilizing STI laws and to make legislative recommendations to amend STI laws to improve project delivery, by November 1, 2026.

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** This act is effective when it becomes law.
