Analysis of: S.L. 2026-50, Part VII

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Part VII of S.L. 2026-50 (House Bill 1126) makes the following changes to the North Carolina Capital Facilities Finance Agency:

- Adds charter and religious schools as participating institutions.
- Provides that the Treasurer serves as the chair of the board of directors.
- Removes the Governor's authority to designate a chair and vice-chair of the board of directors.
- Provides that public hearings for the issuance of bonds must follow requirements in federal law.

This Part became effective July 7, 2026.

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
