OVERVIEW: *House Bill 1193 would designate March as "Marrow Donation Awareness Month" and direct the Department of Health and Human Services to make available information about donating bone marrow donation and transplantation.*

BILL ANALYSIS: House Bill 1193 would designate March as "Marrow Donation Awareness Month." The Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) would be directed to post information about bone marrow donation, transplantation, and registries on its website. A link to the information must be displayed on monitors at drivers license offices around the state, and individuals would be able to indicate their intention to be a bone marrow donor when applying for or renewing a drivers license. \$100,000 would be appropriated to DHHS to conduct a public awareness campaign regarding Marrow Donation Awareness Month.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This bill would be effective July 1, 2026.
