OVERVIEW: *House Bill 124 would adopt the Moravian cookie as the official State cookie.*

CURRENT LAW: State symbols and other official adoptions of the State are found in Chapter 145 of the General Statutes. Currently, North Carolina does not have an official cookie.

BILL ANALYSIS: The bill would amend Chapter 145 of the General Statutes by adding a new section to establish the Moravian cookie as the official cookie of North Carolina.

EFFECTIVE DATE: House Bill 124 would become effective when it becomes law.
