OVERVIEW: House Bill 125 would adopt the Moravian star as the official star of the State.

CURRENT LAW: State symbols and other official adoptions of the State are found in Chapter 145 of the General Statutes. Currently, North Carolina does not have an official State star.

BILL ANALYSIS: House Bill 125 would amend Chapter 145 of the General Statutes by adding a new section to establish the Moravian star as the official star of the State.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This act would become effective when it becomes law.
