OVERVIEW: *House Bill 254 would designate the fourth Thursday of March of each year as Tuskegee Airmen Commemoration Day in North Carolina.*

CURRENT LAW: Chapter 103 of the North Carolina General Statutes designates holidays and other special days. Public holidays in North Carolina are designated in G.S. 103-4.

BILL ANALYSIS: House Bill 266 would amend the Chapter that designates holidays and other special days in North Carolina to add a new statute (G.S. 103-19) declaring the fourth Thursday of March of each year as Tuskegee Airmen Commemoration Day.

EFFECTIVE DATE: The bill would become effective when it becomes law.
