OVERVIEW: *House Bill 35 would designate the month of November as Military Appreciation Month in North Carolina.*

CURRENT LAW: Chapter 103 of the General Statutes recognizes various special days, weeks, and months, including Prisoner of War Day, Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day, and Wounded Heroes Day.

BILL ANALYSIS: House Bill 35 would add a new section to Chapter 103 declaring the month of November as Military Appreciation Month in North Carolina.

EFFECTIVE DATE: The bill would become effective when it becomes law.
