## **OVERVIEW:** House Bill 441 would adopt the loggerhead sea turtle as the State saltwater reptile.

**CURRENT LAW:** State symbols and other official adoptions of the State are found in Chapter 145 of the General Statutes. Currently, North Carolina does not have an official saltwater reptile.

**BILL ANALYSIS:** The bill would amend Chapter 145 of the General Statutes by adding a new section to establish the loggerhead sea turtle (Caretta caretta) as the official saltwater reptile of North Carolina.

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** House Bill 441 would become effective when it becomes law.
