**OVERVIEW:** *The Proposed Committee Substitute (PCS) of House Bill 56 appropriates funds to constituent institutions of The University of North Carolina to account for increased enrollment.*

**BILL ANALYSIS:** The PCS does the following:

**Section 1** provides funds to constituent institutions of The University of North Carolina to account for increased enrollment.

**Section 2** reflects a boilerplate provision regarding applicability of the State Budget Act.

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** Except as otherwise provided, makes the PCS for HB 56 effective retroactively to July 1, 2025.
