

HOUSE BILL 58: Extend Elected Officials' Terms/Kittrell.

OVERVIEW: House Bill 58 would change the term of office for the mayor and members of the board of commissioners for the Town of Kittrell from two to four years, beginning with the 2025 municipal elections.

CURRENT LAW: The officers for the Town of Kittrell consist of a mayor and three commissioners. Officers are elected to serve two-year terms. Elections are conducted using the nonpartisan plurality method, and are held on the Tuesday after the first Monday in November in odd-numbered years.

BILL ANALYSIS: The bill would amend the Charter of the Town of Kittrell to change the term of office for the mayor and members of the board of commissioners from two years to four years, beginning with the officers elected in the 2025 municipal elections.

EFFECTIVE DATE: Effective when it becomes law and applies to elections held on or after that date.
