OVERVIEW: House Bill 597 would designate the osprey as the official State raptor.

**CURRENT LAW:** State symbols and other official adoptions of the State are found in Chapter 145 of the General Statutes. Currently, North Carolina does not have an official State raptor.

**BILL ANALYSIS:** House Bill 597 would add a new section to Chapter 145 of the General Statutes to designate the osprey (Pandion haliaetus) as the official raptor of the State of North Carolina.

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** The act would become effective when it becomes law.
