

HOUSE BILL 67: Healthcare Workforce Reforms, Part VIII: Alleviate the Dangers of Surgical Smoke

2025-2026 General Assembly

Analysis of: S.L. 2025-37, Part VIII Date: August 4, 2025

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Part VIII of S.L. 2025-37 (House Bill 67) does the following:

- Requires hospitals and ambulatory surgical centers to adopt and implement policies that require
 the use of an evacuation/filtering system for surgical smoke that is likely to be generated during a
 surgical procedure.
- Authorizes the Department of Health and Human Services to take adverse action against a hospital or ambulatory surgical facility for violation of this requirement.

This Part becomes effective January 1, 2026.



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
