OVERVIEW: House Bill 701 would designate the 17th day of May as Lafayette Day in North Carolina.

CURRENT LAW: Chapter 103 of the General Statutes recognizes various special days, weeks, and months. The following days have been designated for special recognition in North Carolina: American Family Day, Prisoner of War Day, Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day, Fragile X Awareness Day, Lineman Appreciation Day, Wounded Heroes Day, North Carolina Farmers Appreciation Day, and North Carolina Great Trails State Day.

BILL ANALYSIS: House Bill 701 would add a new section to Chapter 103 declaring the 17th day of May as Lafayette Day in North Carolina.

EFFECTIVE DATE: The bill would become effective when it becomes law.
