OVERVIEW: The PCS for HB 811 would remove the prior contents of the bill and instead require all community colleges to make available a comprehensive firearm safety instruction course to those 18 and older. The PCS would also appropriate one million dollars (\$1,000,000) to be used for the course.

BILL ANALYSIS: The PCS for HB 811 would:

- Require the State Board of Community Colleges to develop a comprehensive firearm safety course (course) in consultation with the North Carolina Criminal Justice Education and Training Standards Commission, law enforcement agencies, and firearms associations.
- Require community colleges to offer the course each semester as a noncurricular extension course to those 18 and older, beginning with the fall 2025 semester.
- Provide one million (\$1,000,000) in annually recurring funds for the biennium to develop and provide funds to establish the course, effective July 1, 2025.

EFFECTIVE DATE: Except as otherwise provided, this act would become effective when it becomes law.
