OVERVIEW: Senate Bill 370 would repeal certificate of need review requirements.

CURRENT LAW: Under current law, new institutional health services and most capital expenditures for healthcare facilities are subject to certificate of need review.

BILL ANALYSIS: Senate Bill 370 would repeal certificate of need review requirements and make conforming changes throughout the General Statutes.

EFFECTIVE DATE: The bill would be effective January 1, 2026.
