OVERVIEW: Senate Bill 405 would allow the North Carolina State Board of Chiropractic Examiners (Board) to establish certification standards to let chiropractors perform acupuncture, clarify that applicants for licensure must receive a degree from an accredited chiropractic program, and make conforming changes.

BILL ANALYSIS: Senate Bill 40 5would allow the Board to establish certification standards to let chiropractors perform acupuncture, clarify that applicants for licensure must receive a degree from an accredited chiropractic program, and make conforming changes.

EFFECTIVE DATE: The bill would be effective October 1, 2025.
